## Evolution of the FIVB Strategic Goals

In 2015, the FIVB launched its Strategic Goals in which nine objectives were established as per the below diagram:



During the 36<sup>th</sup> FIVB Congress that occurred in Cancun, Mexico, in November 2018, the FIVB presented a status of the FIVB Strategic Goals, which can be viewed below:



Additionally, during the 36<sup>th</sup> FIVB Congress, the FIVB Leadership presented a revised version of the FIVB Strategic Goals in which the initial goals were updated, and two additional goals were added. Due to this amendment, the FIVB started adopting the 11 Strategic Goals, which can be seen below:



During the 38<sup>th</sup> FIVB Congress, which occurred in Arhem, the Netherlands, the FIVB provided an update of the FIVB Strategic Goals, which can be viewed below:



By 2022, five (5) out of the 11 Strategic Goals were fully achieved and one (1) objective was partially achieved. Following the creation of Volleyball World SA in 2021, the FIVB commercial entity, the Strategic Goals 3, 4 and 11 were transferred to Volleyball World and are being tracked by this company.

Currently, the FIVB is still engaged in achieving goals 1, 8 and 9, which are kept within FIVB's preview. In addition, the FIVB is working on new strategic goals that should presented on the next Olympic Cycle.
