

The drawing of lots to seed the teams into the playoff will take place 30 minutes after the last match of the Pool Play phase of each gender's competition on Friday. The drawing of lots will determine the seeding. Match-up in the single elimination phase will take place in front of the competition office. Athletes and their head of delegation (if any) are welcome to attend the draw.

PROVISIONAL COMPETITION SCHEDULE

The FIVB and the organizer have a right to modify the schedule provided below in order to accommodate the requests of the host broadcaster and international broadcasters as well as to attract more spectators.

The final competition schedule will be confirmed at the completion of each Preliminary Inquiry respectively for Qualification tournament and Main Draw, while the competition schedule for Round of 12 will be announced with 60 minutes after the drawing of lots.

TEAMS ENTRY PROCEDURE

Tentative Entry List

Any eligible athletes/teams can be entered in the Tentative Entry List through the Volleyball Information System (VIS) until 6 Feb 2023, 11:00 CET before the start of the event.

Confirmed Entry List

Athlete Entry Points are used to determine which teams have earned berth(s) into the Qualification and into the Reserve Team List (Main Draw composition see above).

The Confirmed Entry List will be issued on -14 days before the start of the event (9 Feb 2023).

Late Entries

The enrolment shall be requested by email to snowvolleyball@fivb.com by -7 days, 16 Feb 2023, 11:00 CET latest. Late entries will be possible on the basis of who will enter teams first will first have the right to compete in the Qualification tournament until the 16 teams roster per gender is full. However, late entries after the Confirmed Entry List is published, will be not accepted in the main draw if the MD roster will be completed. This irrespective of the points of the late entry teams.

Wild card requests can be submitted to the FIVB through the NFs 6 Feb 2023, 11:00 CET prior to the start of the event through the form.

The prize money will be paid by the organizer directly to the participating teams onsite at the Competition office in the venue. All athletes must have their Identity Card / Passport to present.

WELCOME AND LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

Closest Airport: Kahramanmaraş Airport

Organiser will not provide local transportation from the official airport to the Hotels.

It is possible to take public buses which depart from the airport to the city center.

During the tournament local transportation will be granted by the organizers as follows:

During the tournament local transportation will be provided between 22.02.2023 — 26.03.2023 and shuttle schedule will be provided at later stage.

Please note: The Organiser will <u>not</u> provide transportation for accompanying persons.

BOARD AND LODGING

The organiser will provide accommodation to the MAIN DRAW athletes as below:

- If a team composed by 3 athletes, a triple room will be provided for that team.
- If a team composed by 4 athletes, then athletes will be accommodated in twin rooms
 2 persons room) to all the Main Draw teams in the Organizer's designated hotel as well as meals from Thursday evening (23 Feb) until Monday morning breakfast (27 Feb).

Athletes will be personally responsible for all extras at the hotel such as mini-bar, phone calls, laundry, etc. to be paid upon checkout.

Local Organisers will not be required to make reservations for coaches, guests, teams' physiotherapists, friends, or family members accompanying the participating athletes.

WITHDRAWAL

The procedure of withdrawal will be as follows:

- a. <u>Before the Confirmed List</u>, the National Federation shall withdraw the team directly in the VIS.
- Between the Confirmed List and the last Monday (17:00 CET) before the event, the National Federation shall send the <u>SV-03</u> form with a medical certificate or letter specifying a Force Majeure,
- c. <u>Between the last Monday (17:00 CET) and the relevant Preliminary Inquiry</u>, the National Federation shall send the <u>SV-O3</u> form or letter specifying a Force Majeure and inform the assigned Technical Delegate. In addition, a monetary sanction of 300 USD is applied for a withdrawal in the main draw and USD 100 for a withdrawals in the qualification tournament,
- d. After the relevant Preliminary Inquiry and if due to an injury, the Team captain shall sign the score sheet at the time and place where such match was originally scheduled even if this match will not be played.





EVENT'S REGULATIONS (SV-06)

After the registration deadline and before the Confirmed List issue date, a National Federation may substitute a Player from a Team or add an additional Player if the Team previously composed only by 3 players, without any consequences, by providing the relevant form. Between the Confirmed List issue date and the Preliminary Inquiry that the Team is due to attend, a National Federation may substitute only two Players per Team from the competition, without any consequences but shall inform the FIVB about it, by providing the relevant form.

The FIVB reserves a right to place a main draw team in the qualification due to a change of players which may affect significantly the entry points of a team. Should the team requesting the change of player(s) have not enough entry points to stay in the main draw, it will be replaced automatically by the highest team enrolled in the qualification in accordance with the entry points as per -14 days prior to the start of the event.

When a medical reason or a Force majeure is to be evidenced, all proofs are submitted in English or with an English translation before the relevant Preliminary Inquiry. The medical reason is evidenced only by a medical certificate. The Force majeure by any reasonable means.

When the player is in the Reserve list, the obligation to evidence the medical reason is not needed.

In case of the withdrawal(s) of team(s) in the Main Draw tournament <u>prior to the start of the completion of the Preliminary Inquiry</u> of the Qualification Tournament, the next eligible team(s) with the highest FIVB Entry Points in the Qualification Tournament shall be picked up to advance to the Main Draw, respecting the regulations of the country quota.

In case of the withdrawal(s) of team(s) in the Main Draw tournament <u>after the completion of Preliminary Inquiry</u> of the Qualification Tournament when the Qualification seeding list and match schedule have been developed, the regulations of the lucky loser draw shall be implemented to determine the extra team(s) qualify to the Main Draw.

The Lucky loser draw regulation is as follows:

- The lucky loser draw is conducted by the assigned FIVB Technical Delegate after the completion of the Preliminary Inquiry of Main Draw;
- The lucky loser draw is implemented among the teams losing the last round of the Qualification Tournament, provided they attend and sign in at the Preliminary Inquiry of Main Draw tournament as eligible 'lucky losers';
- The first draw is between the two highest seeded teams among the eligible 'lucky loser';
- For each additional available spot in the Main Draw, the next highest seeded team must be drawn against the loser of the previous draw;
- This procedure continues until all additional open spots of the Main Draw are filled.

SEEDING

Once all the participating teams are known and have confirmed their presence during the Preliminary Inquiry, the teams will be seeded in the competition bracket. The seeding will be determined by the FIVB Snow Volleyball Ranking points for all involved teams during the Technical Meeting. A draw can be carried out only for teams with the same amount of points even if they have O points.

The Host Country teams must never be placed in the same pool. These team(s) will have their seed increased (i.e. from Seed #8 to Seed #9) until they are in a different pool than already seeded Host Country teams. Should increasing the seed not work (or not be possible), then the seed will be reduced (i.e. from Seed #12 to Seed #11) until the team(s) is placed in a different pool.

Finalized seeding list and the match up & additional detailed information regarding the competition will be published on the FIVB website immediately once the seeding list is established.

PLAYERS' ELIGIBILITY

All athletes participating in the FIVB snow volleyball sanctioned event must:

- Hold the citizenship of the country they represent;
- Register with their respective NF;
- Register with the FIVB through their respective NF;
- Present the 2023 Snow Volleyball NF-Athlete's Commitment signed by the NF and the athlete during the Preliminary Inquiry;
- Present an annual health certificate (SV-10) during the Preliminary Inquiry;
- Undertake the FIVB Anti-Doping education program "Play clean!". For further information please access FIVB online Anti-Doping education program here: http://playclean.fivb.com
- Complete the FIVB Manipulation Course: https://www.fivb.com/development/manipulationcourse
- Complete and modify his/her personal data (such as his/her exact coordinates, bank account information, etc.) through the FIVB beach volleyball Web based application system (http://www.fivb.org/visasp)

UNIFORM AND ACCESSORIES

Uniforms and accessories will be checked during the Preliminary Inquiry by the FIVB Technical Delegate. All athletes will be required to have the necessary clothes and accessories to compete on the snow with low temperature which may be -10C degrees and above.

Football boots with a strong grip on the snow will be also required to play snow volleyball. The shoes, gloves and other accessories should be made from the materials, which do not produce any danger to the players, teammates or opponents.

While athlete's tops will be provided by the Organizers, shorts/leggings and accessories have to be purchased by the athletes and/or provided by their sponsors. Players are permitted to wear equipment composed of a close-fitting t-shirt with long or short sleeves and long tight pants. The FIVB encourages to wear thermal clothes and accessories which can reflect the color(s) of the participating countries. This is to create a country vs country image during the official matches.

Men's athletes may wear shorts over the long tight pants. The uniforms have to be consistent in style, length and color for all players in the team.

Athletes are authorized to use the following accessories:

- a. Visor/cap/hat/headband
- b. Knee and/or elbow pads
- c. Sunglasses
- d. One watch
- e. Gloves
- f. Two Armbands

Sponsor/Manufacturer

No sponsor logos are permitted <u>on close-fitting t-shirts and thermal wear pants</u> except the manufacturer logo that cannot exceed 30cm2. Sponsors logos are allowed on men's shorts and women's leggings (or shorts). There are no limitations concerning the position and size of sponsors logos On the accessories, the athletes are allowed to display a maximum of 2 sponsors (72cm2 each) plus the manufacturer's logo.

REGISTRATION

National Federations can enrol their teams through the FIVB VIS until 6 Feb 2023, 11:00 CET before the start of the competition.










3) Confirm with "OK"




4) Double-click on the registered team. Click on "Add player(s)" and select the players to be added.

ACCREDITATION

Organizers will provide all Organizing Committee members, Officials, referees, athletes, VIPs, journalists, technical staff, court personnel, volunteers, etc. with an official accreditation card and will ensure that only people with appropriate accreditation will access the designated venue areas.

INSURANCE

Athletes need to have their own liability and medical insurance.

MEDICAL-DOPING CONTROLS

The FIVB reserves the right to perform random medical-doping controls of the participating athletes and alcohol tests of the officials, as per FIVB rules and regulations.

I. Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE):

If a player has taken any prohibited substances, he must have a valid Therapeutic Use Exemption Approval (M–8 form) delivered by the FIVB prior to the event, except in case of emergency.

- II. First aid and medical treatment will be provided by the Organizer under the control of the FIVB Technical Delegate.
- First aid facilities, medical doctor and nurse in each competition for the players and spectators.
- First aid at the venue (nurse, medical supplies).
- First aid for players in the hotel or doctors on call.
- III. Ambulance is highly recommended in front of the venue, in any case, the time to get an ambulance should be less than 10 minutes.
- IV. Determination of hospital for possible hospitalization is mandatory.
- VI. Before each match the team manager or teams captain must proceed to the Scorer's table with, the identification of the players (accreditations, ID Cards or passports)
- VII. All team delegations are recommended to take out their own third-party liability and medical insurance. All teams waive any claims on local Organizers and the FIVB for injuries sustained during the event.
- IX. Doping controls may be conducted under the supervision of the FIVB Technical Delegate with the cooperation of the Medical Delegates (if any), in accordance with the FIVB Medical & Anti-Doping Regulations. Doping controls may be conducted at any time by WADA (World Anti-Doping Agency or any other authorized sample collection providers in accordance with FIVB agreements).
